### Project Status

Briefly describe the PACs progress to date.

At the PAC Kick-Off meeting in Harrisburg on Feb. 28, we identified 53 credits that would fulfill general education requirements. We also identified entrance requirements; including passing Praxis I scores, portfolio, clearances, and a 3.0 GPA. We identified some competency areas such as Field Experience (40 hours), Adolescent Development, Cognition, Intro to Special Ed, Technology and ELL. A chart showing current courses in each area at each school is being developed.
