- Framework Standards Subcommittees
 - Not Represented: Northampton CC
- Expanding List of Framework Titles
 - Next Step: Having subcommittees review proposed foundation course titles and make recommendations to TAOC
 - Impact to TAOC Institutions, including state-relateds

Statewide P2P Articulation

- Database/Webpage
- Fall 2012 Compliance
 - Northampton has not identified any degree programs as of Fall 2012
- Pending Agreements
 - Music
 - 4-8 Education
 - Secondary Education

Statewide P2P Articulation: Political Science

- November 13 – Agreement approved by 31-5 vote
- DISCUSSION ITEMS:
 - Proposed effective date – Fall 2014
 - Amendment to clarify “50%” requirement
 - Clarify Research Methods competency in General Foundation Competencies and in Recommended Major-Specific Content

Statewide P2P Articulation: PK-4 Certification

DISCUSSION ITEM:

- Use PDE's Teacher Information System (TIMS) to help facilitate transfer process for P2P students
- Require P2P students to create a profile in TIMS and acquire a PPID# as part of the Transfer Checklist

Statewide P2P Articulation & the Transfer Credit Framework

DISCUSSION ITEM:

- Proposal to remove the requirement of the complete Transfer Credit Framework from all approved Statewide Program Articulation agreements which currently require the complete Framework and replace the requirement with required coursework and/or recommended coursework, as specified in each agreement.
